Features of the SWP Mentoring Programs:

- Meets KSDE Mentoring Program Guidelines beginning in 2015-2016
- Flexibility to meet your needs with 3 options for service
- Variety of communication face to face, virtual, individual and group
- Structured with monthly topics to maximize learning with timely information and interactions
- Observations and feedback with the SWPRSC or the district's eWalkthrough tool to drive instructional conversations

Teacher Mentoring Program Purchasing Options:

1. SWPRSC Comprehensive Mentoring Program with SWPRSC Providing the Mentors

- KSDE approval (pending) District submits SWPRSC as mentoring provider
- District signs assurances to follow the program guidelines
- SWPRSC manages documentation processes and forms
- Pricing: \$500 initial program purchase fee
 - **PLUS** \$1,500 per teacher requiring mentor (2-3 teachers \$1,200 each, 4+ teachers \$1,000 each)

2. SWPRSC Comprehensive Mentoring Program with District Providing the Mentors

- KSDE approval (pending) District submits SWPRSC as provider
- District signs assurances to follow the program guidelines, such as mentor training, and is responsible for assigning mentors at the local level
- SWPRSC manages documentation processes and forms
- Pricing: \$500 initial program purchase fee + \$500 per mentor

3. SWPRSC Mentor Training, Only (District Provides Its Own Local Mentoring Program)

- District is responsible for submitting the district's mentoring program to KSDE for approval
- SWPRSC is listed in the district's mentoring program under the provider in the plan under the mentor training section only
- District manages documentation processes and forms
- Pricing: \$600 per mentor
